As a matter of forewarning, being an extra in movies is hard work. The shoot is rain or shine and there is much waiting involved. We seek those very committed who will stay the entire time. Recreating this portion of Winnipeg history (the 1919 Winnipeg General Strike) will be worth it though.

The meeting place is 47 Gomez, off of Higgins. There is no parking available at Gomez. There will be two parking lots nearer the location of shooting (John Hirsh Place) with shuttles to and from. Having said that, public transit is highly recommended with your destination being 47 Gomez.

The 1919 Self-Costuming Guide

1919 costuming is not difficult. The simple rules are: everyone needs a hat. (No one left the house without a hat.)

Men wore suits and ties (including bow ties), and women wore mid-calf to ankle length dresses, and big hats!
