



CODC PRO Care

ELIGIBILITY AND TIMELINES



REGULAR EAP SERVICES (i.e. Counseling) *Covers Worker and Immediate Family*

The individual must be on the eligibility list.

To get on the eligibility list:

1. The individual must have one (1) hour worked with a CODC eligible employer.
2. The employee information has been reported to CODC by the employer.
3. The employer has paid the associated fees.

The individual will remain on the eligibility list for 5 months after the last month hours were worked.

A&D TESTING

Covers Worker Only
